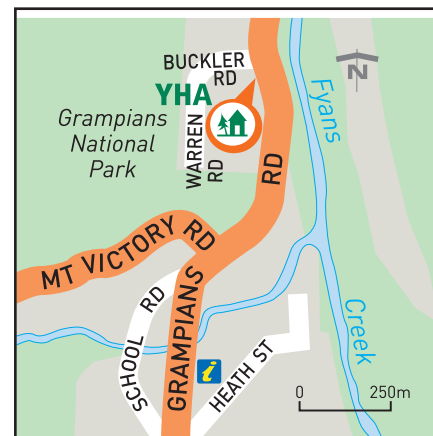




## How To Reach The Hostel

### By Road

Halls Gap is 244km west of Melbourne, in the beautiful Grampians National Park. For those travelling from Stawell, the hostel is on the right hand side, on the corner of Buckler Road. Take Buckler Road for minibus / coach parking at the rear of the hostel.

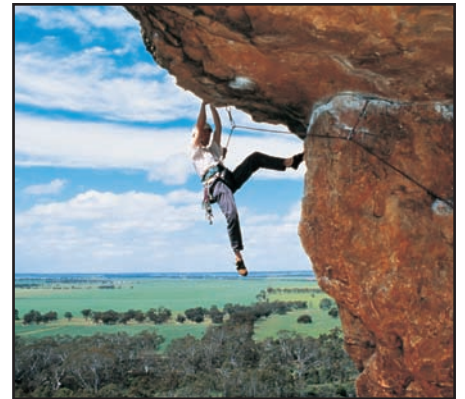

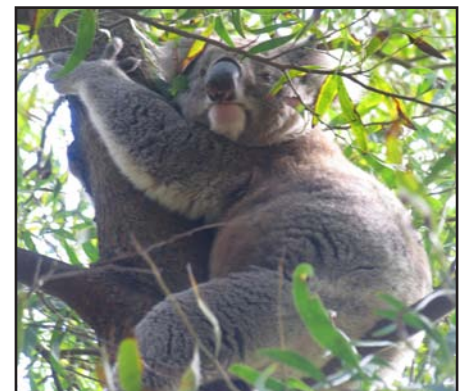

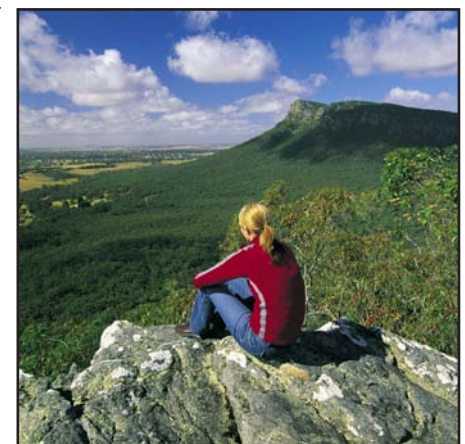
