Bundanoon YHA is an Edwardian era guesthouse with sweeping verandahs for chilling on warm days, a crackling log fire in the lounge for when it's cold and green grassy grounds to lie on and watch the clouds go by. A very relaxed atmosphere makes it the perfect country getaway.

We have a well equipped self-catering kitchen, including a big outside BBQ. There is a spacious dining room with seating for 40, or dine al fresco on the verandah with new made friends. ## Around and About Bundanoon YHA

Bundanoon is the gateway to the magnificent Morton National Park. With scenic lookouts over deep gullies and waterfalls, walks through rainforest and abundant wildlife it has something to offer everyone. Not to be missed is an evening walk to the famous Glow Worm Glen. It's a must and it's free!!

Stroll the village shops and cafes and take home jams and pickles from the local village markets. Play tennis or golf, go paintballing, swim in our community pool. Visit the pub for some classic country ales or take way a pizza or chinese meal to picnic in the National Park. Hire a mountain bike to explore the quite country roads or extensive marked off road trails of Wingello State Forest.

Take a trip to local wineries, adventure at Bungonia or Wombeyan Caves, see historic villages of Berrima and Joadja. Absorb the natural majesty of Fitzroy Falls and the Illawara Fly sensational tree top walk, or canoe on the Shoalhaven, Kangaroo and Wingecarribee rivers.

**Reservations** Recommended, especially for weekends and holidays. Minimum 2 night stay required most weekends.

**Deposits** Credit card details required to secure booking. Alternatively book online at [www.yha.com.au](http://www.yha.com.au) or send a cheque equal to one nights' tariff.

**Refunds and Cancellations** Standard YHA conditions apply, except where advised by management. One weeks notice required for weekend cancellations or full refund if room can be rebooked.

**Check in** Between 5pm and 8.30pm at reception, however the building is generally open all day and is available for the use of expected and registered guests. Late check in by prior arrangement.

**Check out** Please return key to reception and linen to the laundry baskets by 10am.

**Linen** Prices include bed linen, however you will need to provide towels and toiletries. Limited towel hire is available from reception for \$1.30 if you are traveling light.

**Breakfast Hampers** Please book by 8.30p.m. the night before.

**Kitchen** Fully equipped with oven, cook tops, microwave, crockery, cutlery etc.

**Group Catering** Available for 15 or more. Check out 'Let us do it for you' list of options on page 4

**Babies** Cot and high chair available.

**Payphone** There is a payphone in the foyer. Mobile phone reception is ok depending on your provider.

**Internet access** Available for guests during reception hours only. Wireless also available.

**Torches** Available for hire for the Glow Worm adventure. Numbers limited - \$1.50 for one night use.

**Games** Indoor and outdoor games available at reception. Ping pong table and climbing.

**Laundry** Washing machine, clothes line and dryer available. Hair dryer, iron and ironing board available on request.

**Walking maps and information** Available in foyer. Reception staff are a font of local knowledge with access to extensive literature and maps to get you on your way.

## How to Get to Bundanoon YHA

### By Train

Both City Rail and Country Link trains traveling between Sydney and Goulburn/Canberra stop in Bundanoon. Timetables are located in the hostel foyer. Check out [www.cityrail.info](http://www.cityrail.info) and [www.countrylink.info](http://www.countrylink.info)

The hostel is a 1.2km level walk from the station.

### By Car from Sydney

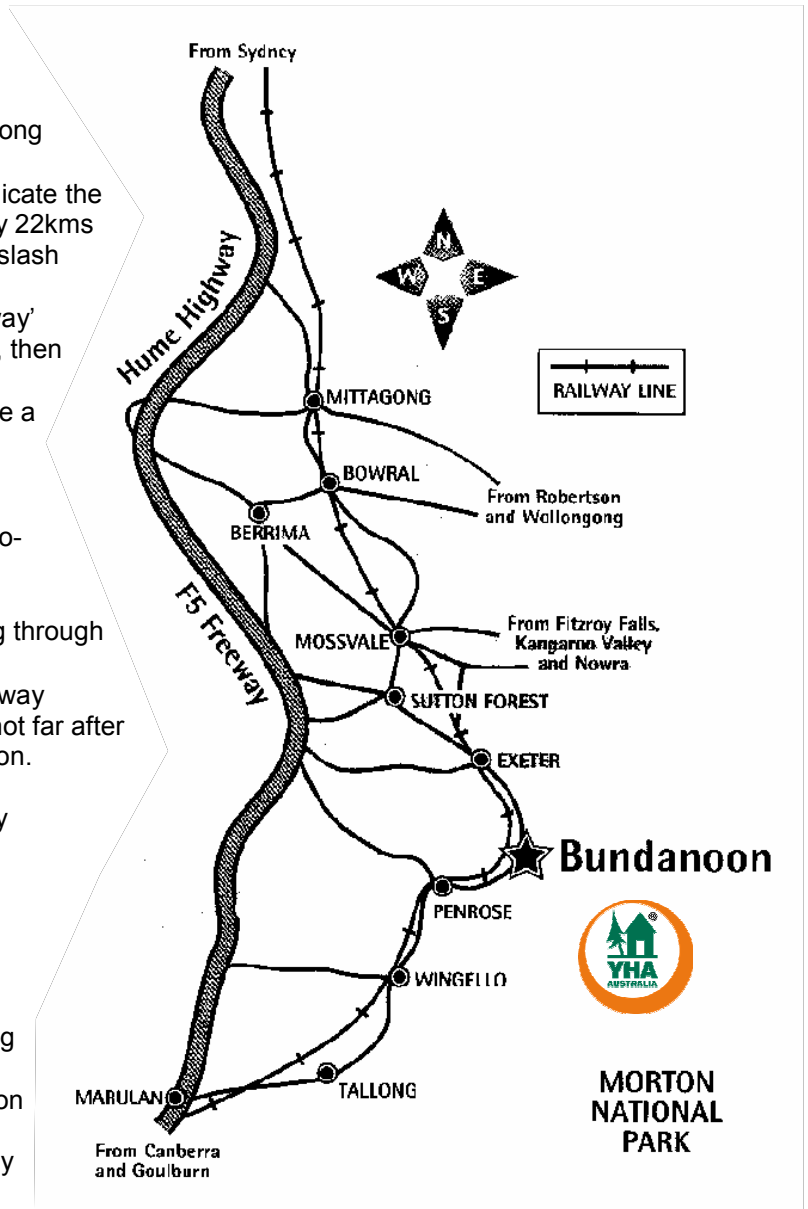
- Take the Hume Highway heading south.
- Continue past the turn off to Mittagong and Bowral.
- Keep a look out for signs which indicate the end of the Freeway - approximately 22kms further. (Looks like a bridge with a slash through it.)
- You will see '2kms to end of Freeway' sign, then '1km to end of Freeway', then 'End of Freeway'.
- Immediately after this last sign, take a LEFT turn to Sutton Forest. This is Golden Vale Road.
- Follow the road right through to a T-intersection. Turn RIGHT, drive towards Sutton Forest Hotel.
- Take the next LEFT to Bundanoon (Exeter/Bundanoon Road), passing through Exeter village.
- This road eventually becomes Railway Avenue. Look for us on the LEFT not far after you enter the outskirts of Bundanoon.

This trip should take you approximately 1.5-2 hours.

### By Car from Canberra

- Take the Hume Highway heading North.
- Pass the turn off to Marulan and then look out for the signs indicating the RTA Heavy Checking Station.
- 500 meters past the checking station there is a turn off to the RIGHT to Bundanoon. This may be a bit tricky to see.
- Follow this road right through to Bundanoon. The railway line will remain on your left hand side. You will pass through the villages of Tallong, Wingello and Penrose.
- When you have entered the main town area you will see shops on your right and the railway line on your left. This is Railway Avenue, continue North on this road for 1.2km and you will find us on the RIGHT.
- Don't panic if you miss the turn off at Marulan. Turn off at the Sally's Corner Truck Stop and McDonalds, cross the Highway and follow the signs to Exeter and Bundanoon.

This trip should take you 1.5-2 hours.
