

4-Day Monkey Mia Adventure Tour

Day 1	<p>Perth-Kalbarri</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Depart Perth 6:45am from the Perth Sightseeing Centre, cnr. Hay and Pier Streets (2 minute walk from Perth City YHA). • Head north to Nambung National Park and stop to explore the famous Pinnacles Desert. • Visit local sand dunes for an adrenaline rush sand boarding down these huge slopes. • Lunch at one of the small fishing towns and a chance for a swim in the Indian Ocean, or a nice stroll along deserted beaches. • Journey through to Geraldton and along the Batavia Coast. During season, wildflowers stops are made en route to the Pink Lakes and the Ocean Gorges (Pot Ally). <p>Meals: Lunch and traditional Australian BBQ for dinner Accommodation: Hostel – Multi-share dorm</p>
Day 2	<p>Kalbarri-Monkey Mia</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short drive to Kalbarri National Park and a bush walk to check out the awesome views of the Murchison River - Z-bends and the famous Natures Window. • Continue north through station country, where we cross Meadow and Nerren Nerren sheep stations, en route to Shark Bay. • Next stop is the Stromatolites (the oldest living things on the planet) and then on to Shell beach, the longest shell beach in the world. • Next a quick stop in Denham (the most westerly town in Australia) before arriving at Monkey Mia Resort for the night. <p>Meals: Breakfast, lunch and traditional Australian BBQ for dinner Accommodation: Multi-share dorm at Monkey Mia Dolphin Resort YHA</p>
Day 3	<p>Monkey Mia-Northampton</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spend the morning at Monkey Mia to see the wild dolphins that come in shore. There is also an opportunity to take an optional cruise on a catamaran. Sea snakes, turtles and tiger sharks may be seen. • lunch is served at the resort before moving on to Eagles Bluff to take in the view of Shark Bay from the cliff tops and see more marine life swimming down below. • Start heading back south to Northampton for a farm stay. <p>Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner Accommodation: Farm stay</p>
Day 4	<p>Northampton-Perth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make the short journey to the Hutt River Province. Listened to Prince Leonard’s story about how and why he seceded from Australia. A unique part of Australia’s history. Bring your passport along if you wish to add another stamp • Depart Hutt River and begin the journey south towards Perth. Stop at the Greenough Wildlife Park - the home of a python breeding centre. • Arrive back in Perth late afternoon <p>Meals: Breakfast and lunch</p>



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
