

	 HOW CAN YOU GET A 2ND YEAR VISA (417)? You can apply for a second year visa if during your first year you work in regional areas for 3 months (88 days) doing specified work including: agricultural work fishing and pearling tree farming and felling mining and construction 	 HOW CAN YOU GET A 2ND YEAR VISA (462) You can apply for a second year visa if during your first year you work in eligible areas of northern or regional Australia for 3 months (88 days) doing specified work in one or more of the following: Tourism & hospitality (northern Australia only) plant & animal cultivation (northern
