SUGGESTED STOPS...

1 PICCANINNIE PONDS

A wetland of international importance, this spectacular underwater world is an explorer's mecca and a diver's dream. Snorkel and diving permit required.

2 BLUE LAKE

From a steel grey in winter to a brilliant turquoise in summer, the changing colours of this enchaining lake in an extinct volcano will take your breath away.

3 MARY MACKILLOP PENOLA CENTRE

Go back in time to the very place where Mary MacKillop began her journey to becoming Australia's first saint.

4 ST MARY'S WINES

6 NARACOORTE CAVES NATIONAL PARK

Explore the caves of this World Heritage site or step back in time some 500,000 years at the Wonambi Fossil Centre.

7 TANTANOOLA CAVES CONSERVATION PARK

Witness the breathtaking array of formations developed over thousands of years in this spectacular dolomite cavern.

PROBE - OBELISK, LONG BEACH

Drive and discover the famous 10km stretch of sand at Long Beach - the perfect spot for swimming, surfing and long walks to the backdrop of a rugged coastline.

10 JACKS POINT PELICAN OBSERVATORY

Walk through the dunes of Coorong National Park to discover a viewing shelter that overlooks the largest breeding colony of Australian pelicans.

See dolphins, seals, whales and seabirds on this spectacular ocean experience with The Big Duck Boat Tours, or climb aboard the horse-drawn tram (the only one of its kind in Australia) to Granite Island.

15 DEEP CREEK CONSERVATION PARK

Camp for the night and rise to hike the Heyson trail where the wild wonder of the largest portion of remaining natural vegetation on the Fleurieu Peninsula awaits.

The southern-most tip of the Fleurieu Peninsula, Cape Jervis is home to the SeaLink Ferry which operates daily and is the departure point to Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island.

It's not a trip to Kangaroo Island if you don't stop to see the natural formations of Admirals Arch and the beautiful windswept shapes and colours of Remarkable Rocks.

24 STOKES BAY

Follow the signs through a rocky passage to discover a secluded, picture perfect swimming beach.
