Getting here

By Car or Bike

Head to Church Point Ferry Wharf. You can get here via Pittwater Rd or McCarr's Creek Rd. This is as far as you can go with a vehicle, you will then have to cross the water by ferry or water taxi.

Parking

There is paid parking directly at Church Point Ferry Wharf, just outside the Pasadena. This can be costly, so for free, untimed parking, search Google maps for Bakers Rd, Church Point.

It is about a 10-15 minute walk from the ferry wharf, so we suggest dropping your food, luggage and passengers at the wharf whilst you park and walk back.

By Public Transport

From the City to Church Point Ferry Wharf

PINK WATER TAXI

From Church Point Wharf

You will need to catch the Church Point ferry to Hall's Wharf. Tickets are purchased on board. Trips are limited so make sure you check them out before leaving.

For trips outside ferry times, you can catch a Pink Water Taxi to Hall's Wharf.

Taxis fit 4-6 people and cost around \$30.

Please note that taxi services stop between 8-10pm.

If you would like a taxi between these times, make sure you text or call them to let them know. After 10pm, there is

unfortunately no way to get to the property, so ensure you take the time to plan your trip.

On Foot

The property can also be reached on foot via West head road and the Towlers Bay Trail.

This takes around 1-2 hours from the parking point at West Head Road, depending on your level of fitness.


Please note that this is a hike through the bush on steep and uneven ground.

Do not attempt if you are unprepared or plan to arrive around or after sunset.

Please also let reception know if you plan to arrive this way so we can assist in the case of an emergency.

By Boat

If you would like to come by boat, there are 2 courtesy moorings in Morning Bay which allow 24hr use only.



Once you get to Hall's Wharf

There will now be a 10-15 minute walk along a fire trail to the property. Keep in mind there are some steep hills!

Take your time and pack light.

Morning bay is a very peaceful place, you'll feel it as soon as you arrive! Please keep in mind that the residents that choose to live here stay for the peace and quiet and to be in nature. Please keep noise to a minimum when walking from the wharf to the trail. We have some neighbours who get very upset with us if guests are very noisy or wander onto their property, Ensure your group is as respectful as possible.

When you get to the top of the stairs from the wharf, simply follow the signs to the YHA.

If you need a wheelbarrow to carry food and bags, at the first right turn after the stairs you will see a tree marked with a big yellow x (see image on the left). The wheelbarrows are stored against the water tank, help yourself.

Our neighbour has kindly let us store the wheelbarrows here for our guests so keep in mind that you are entering someone's property.

After 10-15 minutes and a few big hills you will have arrived!

Don't worry, there's cold water in the fridge and plenty of places to put your feet up when you're here.

Just put the wheelbarrows to the side of the path and you can use them when you head back down. Please take them back to their home next to the water tank.
